APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF OREGON

I, William H. W. Hamilton (Name of Applicant)

of Prineville, (Postoffice), County of Crook

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Little Bear Creek (Name of stream)

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is Three cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigation (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located At the point that Little Bear Creek enters the W 1/2 of NW 1/4 of Sec. 21 (Give distance and bearing to section corner)

being within the NW 1/4 of Sec. 21, Tp. 18 South (Give smallest legal subdivision) (No. N. or S.)

R. 17 East, W. M., in the County of Crook (No. E. or W.)

5. The Main Ditch (Main ditch, canal or pipe line) to be about one mile in length, terminating in the NW 1/4 of SW 1/4 of Sec. 21, Tp. 18 S (Smallest legal subdivision) (No. N. or S.)

R. 17 E, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map. (No. E. or W.)

6. The name of the ditch, canal or other works is The Hamilton Ditch

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

The appropriation for irrigation purposes shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cu. ft. per sec. for each acre irrigated.

The amount of water appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use and not to exceed three-fourths (0.75) cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 23, 1911

and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before

June 23, 1912

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before

June 23, 1913
