

*APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, WALTER W. FOSTER (Name of applicant) of 3323 Belvedere St. NW, Salem, Oregon (Mailing address), State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.04 cubic feet per second. (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is 0.3 for Orchard spraying, domestic use during harvest time for pickers and irrigation including up to 1/2 Ac Garden = 0.1 c.f.s.

4. The point of diversion is located 3160 ft. (N. or S.) and ft. (E. or W.) from the corner of S 74°40'W 3160' from the Section corners of Sections 19, 20, 29 and 30 (See attached map) (If preferable, give distance and bearing to section corner)

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.04 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from a spring

The use to which this water is to be applied is orchard spraying and domestic use in pickers camp including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre of lawn and garden being 0.03 cfs for spraying and 0.01 cfs for domestic

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated _____

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is May 18, 1966

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 7, 1968 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1968

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1969
