*APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon.

I, C. E. Reece, of Rt. 3, Box 715, Roseburg, Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Champagne Creek, a tributary of South Umpqua River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.03 cubic feet per second.

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigation

4. The point of diversion is located 970 ft. N and 1650 ft. E from the SW corner of Section 6

being within the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Sec. 6, Tp. 27S, R. 6W, W. M., in the county of Douglas

5. The Pipe Line to be 912 Ft. (Approx.) in length, terminating in the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Sec. 6, Tp. 27S, R. 6W, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Diversion Works—

6. (a) Height of dam feet, length on top feet, length at bottom feet; material to be used and character of construction

(b) Description of headgate

(c) If water is to be pumped give general description 1/2 hp motor - 1" intake pump

*A different form of application is provided where storage works are contemplated. **Application for permits to appropriate water for the generation of electricity, with the exception of municipalities, must be made to the Hydroelectric Commission.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.03 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Champagne Creek

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is June 13, 1966

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 23, 1968 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1968.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1969.
