*APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Vincent L. Milligan (Name of applicant) of 355 Eola dr. NW, Salem, Ore (Mailing address) State of Ore, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the

following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is A Spring (Name of stream) a tributary of Little North Fork Santiam

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.005 cubic feet per second. (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Domestic including up to 1/2 Ac. Lawn & Garden (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located 640 ft. S (N. or S.) and 340 ft. W (E. or W.) from the NE corner of Sec 15 (Section or subdivision)

(If preferable, give distance and bearing to section corner)

(If there is more than one point of diversion, each must be described. Use separate sheet if necessary)

being within the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 (Give smallest legal subdivision) of Sec. 15, Tp. 9S (N. or S.) R. 2E (E. or W.), W. M., in the county of Marion

5. The (Main ditch, canal or pipe line) to be (Miles or feet) in length, terminating in the (Smallest legal subdivision) of Sec. , Tp. (N. or S.) R. (E. or W.), W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Diversion Works—

6. (a) Height of dam feet, length on top feet, length at bottom feet; material to be used and character of construction (Loose rock, concrete, masonry, rock and brush, timber crib, etc., wasteway over or around dam)

(b) Description of headgate (Timber, concrete, etc., number and size of openings)

(c) If water is to be pumped give general description (Size and type of pump) (Size and type of engine or motor to be used, total head water is to be lifted, etc.)

*A different form of application is provided where storage works are contemplated. **Application for permits to appropriate water for the generation of electricity, with the exception of municipalities, must be made to the Hydroelectric Commission. Either of the above forms may be secured, without cost, together with instructions by addressing the State Engineer, Salem, Oregon.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.005 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from a spring

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic use of one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and garden

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is September 20, 1966

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 5, 1968 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1969

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1970
