APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Ella Licklider (Name of Applicant)

of Baker (Postoffice), County of Baker

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation.

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Griffin Gulch (Name of stream)

tributary of Powder River Watershed

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.1 cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Domestic supply, including water for stock (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located in North east corner of NE 1/4 of Sec. 34 Tp 9 S R 39 E.W.M. as shown and described in map, filed with Application No. 3077 and a blue print from said map accompanies this application

being within the NE NE of Sec. 34, Tp. 9 S (Give smallest legal subdivision) (No. N. or S.)

R. 39 E, W. M., in the county of Baker, State of Oregon (No. E. or W.)

5. The Ditch has already been constructed and the water is carried to premises Main ditch, canal or pipe line to be miles in

length, terminating in the NW SW of Sec. 32, Tp. 9 S, R. 40 E (Smallest legal subdivision) (No. N. or S.) (No. E. or W.)

W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent, for each acre irrigated, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper State officer.

The use of the water under this permit shall be limited to water for domestic use including stock water.

The amount of water appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use and not to exceed 0.1 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The priority date of this permit is January 5, 1917

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 1, 1918 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 1, 1919

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1920
