To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, HUBERT JANIKE & JOYCE V. JANIKE Husband & Wife
of 5121 SW LAMAYON, PORTLAND, ORE
State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is N.W. Unnamed Spring, a tributary of TUALATI RIVER

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is AT 0.015 cubic feet per second

4. The point of diversion is located 1120 ft. S and 1200 ft. W from the NE corner of SECTION 19, Twp 2 S, Rge 2 W, W.M.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.015 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from unnamed spring

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic use of one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and garden and stock being 0.01 cfs for domestic and 0.005 cfs for stock

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is March 24, 1967 for domestic April 26, 1967 for stock

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 10, 1968 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1969

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1970
