

*APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, C. W. LIM (Name of applicant) of RT. 2 Box 101, CANBY (Mailing address), State of OREGON, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Gribble Creek & unnamed reservoir (Name of stream), a tributary of the Molalla River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.28 cubic feet per second. (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.28 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Gribble Creek and reservoir to be constructed under application No. R-43435, permit No. R-4987

The use to which this water is to be applied is supplemental irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir to be constructed under permit No. R-4987 provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is March 30, 1967

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 21, 1968 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1969

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1970
