To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Harold J. & Arvenus M. Steffen (Name of applicant) of 5826 North Omaha Ave. Portland (Mailing address), State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the

following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Spring (Name of stream), a tributary of Crescent Lake

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.005 cubic feet per second. (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

\*\*3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Domestic including up to 1/2 Ac. of lawn & garden (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located 10 ft. N and 20 ft. E from the SW corner of lot 26 BK. 32 Manhattan Beach (Section or subdivision)

(If preferable, give distance and bearing to section corner)

being within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Sec. 29, Tp. 2N R. 10W, W. M., in the county of Tillamook (Give smallest legal subdivision) (N. or S.) (E. or W.)

5. The (Main ditch, canal or pipe line) to be (Miles or feet) in length, terminating in the (Smallest legal subdivision) of Sec. (N. or S.), W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map. (E. or W.)

Either of the above forms may be secured, without cost, together with instructions by addressing the State Engineer, Salem, Oregon.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed .....0.005..... cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from ...a spring.....

The use to which this water is to be applied is ...domestic use of one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and garden.....

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to ..... of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated .....

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is ..... June 27, 1967.....

Actual construction work shall begin on or before ..... February 7, 1969..... and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1969..

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1970....
