

*APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, DONALD B. MILLER (Name of applicant) of RT 1 Bx 28 DAYS CREEK ORE (Mailing address) State of OREGON, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is SOUTH UMPQUA (Name of stream) a tributary of Umpqua

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 1.8 cfs cubic feet per second. For irrigation + .01 cubic ft/sec per acre for two families (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is IRRIGATION + DOMESTIC (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located 12.65 ft. S and 18.40 ft. W from the NE corner of 23 (Section or subdivision)

Domestic Pumps: 7 1/2 HP - 1400 S + 1470 W from NE corner of Sect. 23

1/2 H.P. 915' S + 2156' W from NE corner of Sect. 23 (If preferable, give distance and bearing to section corner)

being within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Sec. 23, Tp. 30 S (Give smallest legal subdivision) (N. or S.)

R. 4 W, W. M., in the county of Douglas

5. The portable pipeline to be 600 feet (Main ditch, canal or pipe line) (Miles or feet) in length, terminating in the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Sec. 23, Tp. 30 S (Smallest legal subdivision) (N. or S.)

R. 4 W, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Diversion Works—

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.555 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from South Umpqua River

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic use of two families, stock and irrigation being 0.01 cfs for domestic, 0.005 cfs for stock and 0.54 cfs for irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is June 30, 1967

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 7, 1969 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1969

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1970
