

*APPLICATION FOR PERMIT CERTIFICATE NO. 43004

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, ROBERT C NAEF (Name of applicant) of 13231 S.E. NIXON AVE, MILWAUKIE, ORE 97222 (Mailing address) State of OREGON, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is CLACKAMAS RIVER (Name of stream), a tributary of WILLAMETTE RIVER

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is .02 C.U.F.T. cubic feet per second. .01 for domestic & .01 for irrigation (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Domestic & Irrigation (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located 250 ft. N and 50 ft. W from the S.E. corner of Lot #2 of attached SKETCH (Section or subdivision)

(NOTE: The point of diversion is at the N.W. corner of Ambrose Foster D.L.C.) (If preferable, give distance and bearing to section corner)

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.015 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Clackamas River

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic use of one family and irrigation being 0.005 cfs for domestic and 0.01 cfs for irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is July 24, 1967

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 7, 1969 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1969...

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1970..
