This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed ..... 0.11 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Champoeg Creek and reservoir to be constructed under application No. R-43213, permit No. R-5064.

The use to which this water is to be applied is supplemental irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to ..... 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir to be constructed under permit No. R-5064 provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall be subject to the terms of an agreement between Arthur McKay, Patrick Johnston, Walter Wilmes and Neal Miller recorded at page 979, Volume 4, Miscellaneous Records of the State Engineer and by reference made a part hereof.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is ..... February 28, 1968.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before ..... April 15, 1969 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1970.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1971.
