All of the following described property in Section 9, and Section 16, Twonship 26 South, Range 4 West, W.M., Douglas County, Oregon: BEGINNING at a point marked with a 3/4" iron rod on the southerly right of way line of the Wilbur-Glide Highway (County No. 200) from which the Section corner common to sections 8, 9, 16 and 17, Township 26 South, Range 4 West, W. M., bears North 81 degrees 48' West 3674.4 feet; thence South 310 feet, to the meander line on the right bank of the North Umpqua River, thence downstream along the said meander line to a point on the westerly line of the Fritz and Patricia H. Sterchi property as described in Volumn 366, Page 1 of Book of Records, Douglas County, Oregon; thence leaving said meander line and running North along said westerly line of said Sterchi property to a 3/4" iron rod on the southerly right of way line of said Wilbur-Glide Highway, thence along said southerly right of way line in an easterly direction to the point of beginning, containing 19.5 acres, more or less.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.005 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from North Umpqua River

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic use of one family

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is November 3, 1967

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 17, 1969 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1970.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1971.
