

*APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Willard C Bristlin (Name of applicant) of Box 657 Rt 2 Oregon City, Oregon (Mailing address) State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is UNNAMED SPRING (Name of stream), a tributary of Clackamas River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 1/300 cubic feet per second. (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is 1 Family domestic use (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located 485 ft. South and 4 ft. West from the S.W. corner of J.S. CHURCH DONATION LAND CLAIM IN section 23 Township 2 South Range 3 East, Willamette Meridian. (Section or subdivision) (If preferable, give distance and bearing to section corner)

SW of SW (If there is more than one point of diversion, each must be described. Use separate sheet if necessary) being within the Tax Lot 1-00 of Sec. 23, Tp. 2 S, R. 3 E, W. M., in the county of Clackamas. (Give smallest legal subdivision) (N. or S.)

5. The Pipe (Main ditch, canal or pipe line) to be 200 ft (Miles or feet) in length, terminating in the Tax Lot 1-00 of Sec. 23, Tp. 2 S, R. 3 E, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map. (Smallest legal subdivision) (N. or S.)

Diversion Works—

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.003 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from a spring

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic use of one family

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is December 11, 1967

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 7, 1969 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1970

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1971
