APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, City of Forest Grove (Name of Applicant)

of Forest Grove, County of Washington (Postoffice)

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Branches of Clear Creek (Name of stream), tributary of Gales Creek (Tualatin R)

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is (0.8) Eight-tenths cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is a supplemental supply to increase the present water supply of the City for municipal purposes. (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located 1332 feet South and 1121 feet East from the one-fourth corner of Sections 13 and 24, being within the SW NE Sec. 24, and 1467 feet north and 1779 feet west from the one-fourth corner between Sections 13 and 24.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent, for each acre irrigated, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper State officer.

The use of the water under this permit shall be limited to a supplemental supply to increase the present water supply of the City of Forest Grove for municipal purposes.

The amount of water appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use and not to exceed 0.8 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation.

The priority date of this permit is March 29, 1917

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 10, 1918

and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 1, 1919

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before

October 1, 1920
