The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 2.0 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from South Santiam River and reservoir to be constructed under application No. R-45202, permit No. R-5151

The use to which this water is to be applied is recreation, fish culture and beautification--Waverly and Timber Linn Lakes

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated _____

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is May 29, 1968

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 1, 1969 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1970.
