To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Robert A. Weaver (Name of applicant) of Rt. 4 Box 221 Hillsboro, 97123 (Mailing address), State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the

following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Weaver Reservoir (Name of stream), a tributary of Tualatin R.

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 7.54 cfs (cubic feet per second). (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use 7.5 acre feet stored water only and shall not exceed ~~7.5 acre feet per year~~ measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Weaver Reservoir to be constructed under application No. R-44722, permit No. R-5291

The use to which this water is to be applied is supplemental irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to ~~5 acre feet per year~~ a diversion of 2 1/2 acre feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is April 18, 1968

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 15, 1970 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1970

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1971
