*APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

CERTIFICATE NO. 44385

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Leon L. Foster (Name of applicant) of Camp Sherman (Mailing address) State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the

following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is small spring, a tributary of the Metolius River, a tributary of Deschutes River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.20 cfs cubic feet per second.

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is domestic for 14 families and a 24 unit trailer park with 0.60 acres lawn.

4. The point of diversion is located 100 ft. N. and 610 ft. E. from the SW corner of SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Sec. 10, Tp. 13S. R. 9E. W.M.

being within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Sec. 10, Tp. 13S. R. 9E., W. M., in the county of Jefferson

5. The pipe lines will be about 1200 ft to be in length, terminating in the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Sec. 10, Tp. 13S. R. 9E., W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Diversion Works— Will be a small 1 1/2 HP pump.

6. (a) Height of dam feet, length on top feet, length at bottom feet; material to be used and character of construction

(b) Description of headgate

(c) If water is to be pumped give general description 1 1/2 HP Barnes pump

Water will be used for domestic and lawns for 14 families West of creek and 24 trailers with 0.60 acres of lawn in trailer park.

*A different form of application is provided where storage works are contemplated. **Application for permits to appropriate water for the generation of electricity, with the exception of municipalities, must be made to the Hydroelectric Commission.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.10 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from a spring

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic use of fourteen families and 24-unit trailer park including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and garden

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is June 5, 1968

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 14, 1970 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1970.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1971.
