

# To Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, CARL Lee MASON (Name of applicant)  
of Idley Rd RT. Box 529, Roseburg, (Mailing address)  
State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, **SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:**

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation .....

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is NORTH Fork Deer Creek (Name of stream), a tributary of South Umpqua River.

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.3 cubic feet per second. (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

\*\*3. The use to which the water is to be applied is IRRIGATION (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located 515 ft. S (N. or S.) and 962 ft. W (E. or W.) from the NE corner of SE 1/4 Sec. 20 T27S R4W. (Section or subdivision)

Chrisler and Ethel May Chrisler as recorded in Vol. 101, Deed Records of Douglas County, said point being South 89 8 1/2' East 1342.6 feet and North 0 57' East 651.6 feet from the Southwest corner of Donation Claim No. 44 in Township 27 South, Range 4 West, Willamette Meridian, said point also being on the Northerly boundary of the County Road known as Buckhorn road; thence South 88 28' 30" East along said Northerly line 120 feet to the line of the lands described in that certain contract between G.A. This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.03 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from North Fork Deer Creek

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is August 9, 1968

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 19, 1970 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1970

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1971
