The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1.5 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Willow Creek and reservoir to be constructed under application No. R-45443, permit No. R-5371

The use to which this water is to be applied is fish culture and recreation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated _____

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
