To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Eugene F. Villwock (Name of applicant) of Rt. 1 Box 170 Dallas (Mailing address) State of Oregon 97330, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the

following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Villwock Reservoir, a tributary of Salt Creek Yamhill River (Name of stream)

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 1.92 ac. ft. cubic feet per second (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigation (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located 120 ft. S and 180 ft. W from the S.E. corner of James Fredrick D.L.C. Sec. 8 250' E 650' S N.W. corner of (Section or subdivision)

being within the N.W. 1/4 of Sec. 8, Tp. 7 S (Give smallest legal subdivision) (N. or S.)

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1.9 af stored water only ~~which is to be measured~~ measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from reservoir to be ~~constructed~~ constructed under application No. R-45737, permit No. R-5428

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to ~~of one cubic foot per~~ ~~second to its equivalent for each acre irrigated~~ a diversion of 2 1/2 acre feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is February 5, 1969

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 25, 1970 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1971

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1972
