

*APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Glenn Walters (Name of applicant) of Route 4, Box 142 Hillsboro (Mailing address) State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 17.0 acre feet stored water only ~~cube feet per second~~ measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from reservoir to be constructed under application No. R-46287, permit No. R-5442

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to ~~of one cubic foot per second~~ a diversion of 2 1/2 acre feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is August 7, 1969

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 9, 1970 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1971.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1972.
