This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent, for each acre wrighted, and shall be subject

to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper State officer.
