To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the

following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Diversion Works—

6. (a) Height of dam 2.5 feet, length on top 40 feet, length at bottom
30 feet; material to be used and character of construction loose rock
(Loose rock, concrete, masonry, rock and brush, timber crib, etc., wasteway over or around dam)

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1.3 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from John Day River and two reservoirs to be constructed under application No. R-46147, permit No. R-5487

The use to which this water is to be applied is sprinkling log decks, fire protection, log storage, operating boilers for steam vats and dry kilns.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is June 23, 1969

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 16, 1971 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1971...

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1972...
