This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from unnamed spring and stream, water to be diverted from the unnamed spring when available; with any deficiency in the available supply from spring to be made up by appropriation from an unnamed stream provided that the total quantity diverted from both sources shall not exceed 0.01 cfs.

The use to which this water is to be applied is for the domestic use of one family including the irrigation of lawn and garden not to exceed 1/2 acre in area.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is August 5, 1969

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 24, 1971 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1972. Extended to Oct. 1 1973

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1973.
