To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Josephine County - A Body Politic
of Courthouse, Grants Pass
State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Lake Selmac
McMullen Creek, a tributary of Deer Creek

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use acre feet of stored water only and shall not exceed 5.0 ~~acre feet per second~~ measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from reservoir to be constructed under application No. R-46777, permit No. R-5552

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation and domestic use in park, being 2.0 af for domestic use and 3.0 af for irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to ~~acre feet per acre~~ a diversion of 3/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is February 27, 1970

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 13, 1971 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1972..

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1973...
