

APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, F H Hastay (Name of Applicant)

of Grants Pass R.F.D. No. 1, County of Josephine

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon subject to existing rights:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Springs, tributary of Jump-Off-Joe (Rogue River)

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is .08 cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigation (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located 300 feet east of the Northwest corner of Section 5 Twp 35 S R 5 W, thence 200 feet South of section line

being within the NW 1/4 of NW 1/4 of Sec. 5, Tp. 35 S, R. 5 W, W. M., in the county of Josephine

5. The pipe line to be 80 rods

miles in length, terminating in the SW 1/4 of SW 1/4 of Sec. 32, Tp. 34 S, R. 5 W, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

6. The name of the ditch, canal or other works is Hastay Pipe Line

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, sub-  
ject to the following limitations and conditions: If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to  
one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent, for each acre irrigated, and shall be subject  
to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper State officer.  
The use of the water under this permit shall be limited to water for irrigation  
purposes.

The amount of water appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial  
use and not to exceed 0.04 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of

rotation. The priority date of this permit is August 30, 1917  
Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 12, 1918 and shall  
thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before  
June 1, 1919

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before  
October 1, 1920
