The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use
and shall not exceed0.8
stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Hurricane Creek

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation
If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to1/40 of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of
not to exceed 32 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation
meason of each year,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
The priority date of this permit isJuly 1, 1970
Actual construction work shall begin on or beforeAugust 25, 1972 and shall
thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1973
Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1974.
