

*APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Gerald Morgan (Name of applicant) of Rt. 2 Box 172 Monmouth 97341 (Mailing address) State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Onn. Spring, Unn. Stream & Reservoir (Name of stream), a tributary of N. Fk. Pedee Cr.

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.27 cfs cubic feet per second. (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is 0.01 cfs from spring for domestic use, 0.25 cfs Irrig & 0.01 cfs Stock from Str. & Res. (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located 2630 ft. S and 510 ft. W from the NE corner of NE Cor. Section 17 (Section or subdivision)

Spring loc. 380' W & 2780' S from NE Cor. Sect. 17 (If preferable, give distance and bearing to section corner)

being within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Sec. 17, Tp. 9S (Give smallest legal subdivision) (N. or S.)

R. 6W, W. M., in the county of Polk (E. or W.)

5. The pipe line (Main ditch, canal or pipe line) to be movable (Miles or feet) in length, terminating in the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Sec. 17, Tp. 9S (Smallest legal subdivision) (N. or S.)

R. 6W, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map. (E. or W.)

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Diversion Works—

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.21 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from unnamed stream, spring and reservoir to be constructed under application No. R-47507, permit No. R-5723

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic use for one family and stock and irrigation being 0.005 cfs for domestic use from spring 0.2 cfs for irrigation and 0.005 cfs for stock from stream and reservoir.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir to be constructed under permit No. R-5723

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is September 8, 1970

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 11, 1973 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1973.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1974.
