

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, M.F. McLellan (Name of applicant)
of P.O. Box 108 Tillamook 97141 (Mailing address),
State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the

following described public waters of the State of Oregon, **SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:**

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is an un-named creek (Name of stream),
a tributary of Kilches River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.0325
cubic feet per second. (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is 2 domestic dwellings, one acre of irrigation.
(Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)
DOMESTIC #1 = 0.010 ; DOMESTIC #2 = 0.010 ; IRRIGATION = 0.0125 Total = 0.0325 cfs.

4. The point of diversion is located 2467 ft. South and 3151 ft. West from the NE
corner of section 33 (Section or subdivision)

being within the SE⁴NW⁴ of Sec. 33, Tp. 1 N.,
R. 9 W., W. M., in the county of Tillamook

5. The pipe line to be 1028 feet
in length, terminating in the NE⁴SW⁴ of Sec. 33, Tp. 1 N.,
R. 9 W., W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from unnamed creek

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic use for two families and irrigation being 0.01 cfs for domestic use and 0.01 cfs for irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is September 11, 1970

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 18, 1973 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1973.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1974.
