This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 5.0 gallons per minute ~~cubic feet per second~~ measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from a spring, unnamed draw and reservoir to be constructed under application No. R-48807, permit No. R-5803

The use to which this water is to be applied is stock and recreation and fish culture being 2 gallons per minute for stock use and 3 gallons per minute for recreation and fish culture

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is January 13, 1972

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 27, 1973 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1974.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1975.
