following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

- The source of the proposed appropriation is an unnamed stream & reservoir tributary of Gate Creek, a tributary of McKenzie River

- The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.04 cubic feet per second being 0.0125 cfs for Irrigation and 0.0275 for maint. of fish pond

- The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigation and maintenance of a fish pond, irrigation from the stream only

- The point of diversion is located 2/28 ft. N and 1928 ft. E from the SW corner of section 27, T 16S R 2E

All of that part of the West one half of the Northeast one quarter of the Southwest one quarter of Section 27, Township 16 South, Range 2 East of the Willamette Meridian, in Lane County, Oregon, lying North of the centerline of Gate Creek and North and West of a small creek which runs Southwesterly through said tract and South of the County Road.

Also the West 220 feet of that part of the West one half of the Northeast one quarter of the Southwest one quarter of Section 27, Township 16 South, Range 2 East of the Willamette Meridian, lying North of the County Road, all in Lane County, Oregon.

Subject to easement for roadway granted to Kathleen Hoffman, by instrument recorded April 27th 1956, Clerks filing No. 83665, Lane County Oregon Deed Records. Grantees reserve the right to use the present roadway from County Road to the Joe R. Hart dwelling.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from an unnamed stream and reservoir to be constructed under application No. R-48506, permit No. R-5814

The use to which this water is to be applied is fish culture and irrigation being 0.01 cfs from stream and reservoir for fish culture and 0.01 cfs from stream only for irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir to be constructed under permit No. R-5814

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is July 28, 1971

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 19, 1973 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1974

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1975
