To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, LYNK WEBB (Name of applicant) of P.O. Box 177, Yamhill, Oregon (Mailing address), State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the

following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is an un-named spring (Name of stream), a tributary of flowing into Sand Lake

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 1/100 CFS cubic feet per second. (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Domestic (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located 2882.68 ft. North and 2093.55 ft. East from the S.W. corner of section 29, T. 3 S., R. 10 W., W.M. (Section or subdivision)

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Diversion Works—

6. (a) Height of dam 4 feet, length on top 6 feet, length at bottom 6 feet; material to be used and character of construction concrete (Loose rock, concrete, masonry, rock and brush, timber crib, etc., wasteway over or around dam)

(b) Description of headgate concrete - 1 inch (Timber, concrete, etc., number and size of openings)

(c) If water is to be pumped give general description pump (Size and type of pump) (Size and type of engine or motor to be used, total head water is to be lifted, etc.)

*A different form of application is provided where storage works are contemplated. **Application for permits to appropriate water for the generation of electricity, with the exception of municipalities, must be made to the Hydroelectric Commission. Either of the above forms may be secured, without cost, together with instructions by addressing the State Engineer, Salem, Oregon.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from an unnamed spring

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic use for one family

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is June 11, 1971

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 30, 1974 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1974.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1975.
