

*APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Wendelyn O. Trapp of Rt # Box 919 Roseburg Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Tensile C. a tributary of Lookingglass C.

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.04 cubic feet per second.

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigation 0.02 Domestic 0.02

4. The point of diversion is located 700 ft. S and 20 ft. E from the N.W. corner of Section 31

being within the N.W. 1/4 N.W. 1/4 of Sec. 31, Tp. 28 S, R. 7 W., W. M., in the county of Douglas

5. The 200 ft pipe to be in length, terminating in the N.W. 1/4 N.W. 1/4 of Sec. 31, Tp. 28 S, R. 7 W., W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.025 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Tenmile Creek

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic use for 2 families and irrigation being 0.005 cfs for domestic use and 0.02 cfs for irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is June 13, 1972

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 27, 1974 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1975

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1976
