

*APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Donald Mosher (Name of applicant) of Route 2, Box 717-A (Mailing address), Coos Bay (City), State of Oregon, 97420 (Zip Code), do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is spring (Name of stream), a tributary of flows toward Miner Creek

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.005 cubic feet per second (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Domestic (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located ft. and ft. from the corner of North 57° 27' 48" East a distance of 690.73 feet from the Southwest corner of Section 3, Township 26, Range 14 West, W.M., Coos County. (If preferable, give distance and bearing to section corner)

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.005 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from a spring

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic use for 1 family

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is November 20, 1973

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 21, 1975 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1976...

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1977...
