The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use
and shall not exceed 0.10 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the
stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from a spring

The use to which this water is to be applied is supplemental supply for recreation.....
use in Reservoir constructed under permit No. R-5481.....

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per
second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated


