This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

The appropriation for irrigation purposes shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cu. ft. per sec. for each acre irrigated, balance for domestic supply.

The amount of water appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use and not to exceed Six (6.00) cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before Aug 24, 1911

and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before

Aug 24, 1913

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before

Aug 24, 1915
