*APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Jose C. Nelson (Name of applicant)
of 1606 Murphy Creek Rd. (Mailing address), Summit Pass (City),
State of Oregon 97526 (Zip Code), do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the

following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

a tributary of Applegate River

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.015 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Murphy Creek

The use to which this water is to be applied is for irrigation and domestic use for one family, being 0.01 c.f.s. for irrigation and 0.005 c.f.s. for domestic

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is March 5, 1974

Actual construction work shall begin on or before December 9, 1976 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1977

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1978
