To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, E A Thompson (Name of Applicant) of 1002 Northwestern Bank Bldg., Portland (Postoffice), County of Multnomah State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon subject to existing rights:

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Springs in NW NE and SW NE Sec. 33 (Name of stream) T 12 S R 12 E, tributary of Crooked River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 3.0 cubic feet per second.

STATE OF OREGON, County of Marion, ss.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent, for each acre irrigated, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper State officer.

The right to the use of water herein granted is limited to 1 second foot for domestic purposes and 2 second feet for the development of 23 horsepower.

The amount of water appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use and not to exceed 3.0 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The priority date of this permit is September 5, 1918

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 20, 1919 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 1, 1922

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1924
