To Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Norman Krambeal (Name of applicant) of P.O. Box 185 (Mailing address), Gold beach (City), State of Oregon (Zip Code) 97444, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is a spring, an unnamed stream, & reservoir, a tributary of Rogue River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.02 cubic feet per second being 0.01 cfs from spring for domestic supplies and 0.01 cfs from unnamed stream & Reservoir for Esthetic

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is 0.01 cfs for Domestic use including irrigation of a lawn or garden not to exceed 2 acres and 0.01 cfs for Esthetic domestic

4. The point of diversion is located 374 ft. S. and 69 ft. W. from the 1/4 corner on the E. side of Sec 29 Reservoir located 190' S & 180' W from the E 1/4 cor Sec. 29

(If preferable, give distance and bearing to section corner)

(If there is more than one point of diversion, each must be described. Use separate sheet if necessary)

both being within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Sec. 29, Tp. 36 S

R. 14 W., W. M., in the county of Curry

5. The domestic pipeline to be 370 ft. in length, terminating in the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Sec. 29, Tp. 36 S

R. 14 W., W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from an unnamed stream and Reservoir to be constructed under Application No. R-53370, Permit No. R- 6342, being 0.01 c.f.s. from stream for domestic and 0.01 from stream and reservoir for esthetics.

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic use for one family and esthetics

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is July 2, 1975

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 13, 1977 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1977...

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1978...
