To Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, James and Jerri Bealer (Name of applicant)
of Route 1, Box 189 CC, Pendleton (Mailing address) (City)
State of Oregon, 97801 (Zip Code), do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the

following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Umatilla River (Name of stream)
a tributary of Columbia River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0;45
cubic feet per second or 201 G.P.M. (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigation (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located 140 ft. N and 681 ft. N from the NE
corner of SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Of Section 4 (N. or S.) (E. or W.) (Section or subdivision)

being within the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Sec. 4, Tp. 2N,
R. 34E, W. M., in the county of Umatilla (Give smallest legal subdivision) (N. or S.) (E. or W.)

in length, terminating in the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Sec. 4N, Tp. 2N,
R. 34E, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map. (Main ditch, canal or pipe line) (Miles or feet) (Smallest legal subdivision) (N. or S.) (E. or W.)

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.22 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Umatilla River

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/30th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is November 1, 1974

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 4, 1977 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1977.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1978.
