To Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, HOWARD SCHIERHOLZ (Name of applicant) of RT 3, Box 521, Junction, City Monroe (Mailing address) (City) State of OREGON, 97448 (Zip Code), do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.09 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Long Tom River and Fern Ridge Reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-1625.

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-1625 and is subject to the terms and conditions of contract No. 14-06-100-7486 between the Bureau of Reclamation and the applicant, a copy of which is on file in the records of the Water Resources Department.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is January 5, 1976

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 3, 1977 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1977...

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1978...
