### To Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Lloyd Nixon (Name of applicant)  
of Star Pt 2 Box 245 (Mailing address), Foster One (City),  
State of Oregon (Zip Code) 97345, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the

following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

- The source of the proposed appropriation is EAST Fork Lewis Creek (Name of stream), a tributary of SOUTH SASTIAN
- The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 5 gpd cubic feet per second to of 1 cubic foot per sec (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)
- The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigation (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)
- The point of diversion is located 155.2 ft. N and 310 ft. W from the SE corner of Section 13 T 13 S R 1 E W.M. (Section or subdivision)

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from East Fork Lewis Creek

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is April 19, 1976

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 23, 1977 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1978

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1979
