To Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

State of Oregon, 97201 (Zip Code), do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the

following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed .....0.01..... cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from an unnamed stream and Reservoir to be constructed under application No. R-54256, permit No. R- 6477

The use to which this water is to be applied is a duck pond

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to ..... of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated .....

The right allowed herein shall be subordinate and inferior to all future rights for beneficial consumptive use.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 5, 1976 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1978
