APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, T E Hadfield (Name of Applicant) of Ashland (Postoffice), Jackson County of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon subject to existing rights:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Ashland Creek - Helman Ditch (Name of stream), tributary of Bear Creek

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 3/100 cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigation (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located Headgate Helman Ditch (Give distance and bearing to section corner)

being within the NW 1/4 of NW 1/4 of Sec. 9, Tp. 39 S (No. N. or S.) R. 1 E, W. M., in the county of Jackson (No. E. or W.)

5. The Helman Ditch (Main ditch, canal or pipe line) to be 1/2

miles in length, terminating in the NW SW of Sec. 4, Tp. 39 S (Smallest legal subdivision) (No. N. or S.)

R. 1 E W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map. (No. E. or W.)

6. The name of the ditch, canal or other works is Helman Ditch (Old)

This land was originally owned by A D Helman, who built ditch and took out water right for 4 acres in this particular 40 acres. He did not specify the tracts to be covered by water right. This tract has used water for a number of years and wishes to be protected by a fixed right and hereby asks Water board for such right. This ditch runs over 300 ft. thru owner's land and lays waste to a considerable strip of land. The owner should derive some benefit from it.

any water under this permit.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, sub-
ject to the following limitations and conditions: If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to
one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent, for each acre irrigated, and shall be subject
to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper State officer.

The right to the use of water herein granted is limited to irrigation purposes.

The amount of water appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial
use and not to exceed 0.02 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of
rotation. The priority date of this permit is May 12, 1919

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 16, 1920 and shall
thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before
June 1, 1921

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before
October 1, 1922
