To Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Jean H. Day (widow) (Name of applicant)  
of P.O. Box 127 (Mailing address), Coos Bay (City),  
State of Oregon, 97420 (Zip Code), do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the

following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is School Creek (Name of stream), a tributary of East Fork "Millicoma River"

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.01 cubic feet per second (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Domestic Use (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located N 85° 17' 39" E, 720.76 feet 59. ft. North and 10. ft. East from the South 1/4 corner of Section 25, Township 24 South, Range 11 West, W.M. (Section or subdivision)

(If preferable, give distance and bearing to section corner)  
(If there is more than one point of diversion, each must be described. Use separate sheet if necessary)  
being within the Southwest 1/4 & Southeast 1/4 of Sec. 25, Tp. 24 South, R. 11 West, W. M., in the county of Coos (Give smallest legal subdivision) (N. or S.) (E. or W.)

5. The Pipeline (Main ditch, canal or pipe line) to be 1,420 feet (Miles or feet) in length, terminating in the Southwest 1/4 of Sec. 25, Tp. 24 South, R. 11 West, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map. (Smallest legal subdivision) (N. or S.) (E. or W.)

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.005 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Schools Creek

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic use for one family

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is September 10, 1976

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 12, 1978 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1978

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1979
