The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use
and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the
stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from 2 springs

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic use for one family

..... including the irrigation of lawn and garden not to exceed 1/4 acre in area
