To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Stanley R. Anderson & Janet K. Anderson
of P.O. Box 286, Port Orford
State of Oregon, 97465, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the

following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is spring, a tributary of Elk River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.005 cubic feet per second

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is domestic supplies

4. The point of diversion is located 446 ft. S. and 547 ft. E. from the N.W. corner of the N.E. 1/4 of the S.W. 1/4 of Section 21, Township 32 South, Range 15 West, Willamette Meridian, Curry County, Oregon

being within the N.E. 1/4 of the S.W. 1/4 of Sec. 21, Tp. 32S., R. 15W., W. M., in the county of Curry

5. The Pipe line (1 1/2" Plastic) to be 375 ft. ± in length, terminating in the N.E. 1/4 of the S.W. 1/4 of Sec. 21, Tp. 32S., R. 15W., W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

6. (a) Height of dam feet, length on top feet, length at bottom feet; material to be used and character of construction

(b) Description of headgate

(c) If water is to be pumped give general description 1/3 H.P. Electric Pump

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.005 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from a spring

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic use for one family

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is March 1, 1977

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 4, 1978 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1978

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1979
