do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described waters of the State of Oregon:

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is a spring for domestic & Buck Creek for Irrig, a tributary of Alder Creek

2. The point of diversion is to be located 1740 ft. N and 2200 ft. E from the SW corner of Section 9 (N. or S.) (E. or W.)

Buck Cr. Div. Loc: - 1040' N. & 1890' E (Public Land Survey Corner)

also from the SW corner of Section 9 being w/in NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 9 (If there is more than one point of diversion, each must be described)

Permit to appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.1 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Buck Creek and a spring

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation and domestic use for two families; being 0.09 c.f.s. from Buck Creek for irrigation and 0.01 c.f.s. from spring for domestic use.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is April 4, 1977

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 28, 1978 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1979

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1980
