\*APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Meyerhaeuser Company, of P.O. Box 389, North Bend, Oregon 97459, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation Tacoma, Washington January 18, 1900.

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is South Fork of the Coos River, a tributary of Coos River.

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 3.3 cubic feet per second (1500 gal. min. Capacity) 24 hr. vol. est. 250 M. Gals.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is industrial use - fire protection, log sprinkling, and equipment washing.

4. The point of diversion is located 150 ft. N. and 550 ft. E. from the NW corner of Sec. 33, T. 25 S., R. 11 W., W.M.

being within the Lot 7 of Sec. 28, Tp. 25 S., R. 11 W., W.M., in the county of Coos.

5. The Pipeline to be 4400 Ft. in length, terminating in the Lot 6 of Sec. 28, Tp. 25 S., R. 11 W., W.M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

at our Dellwood Logging Terminal in case of Log Deck or shop fires.  
Lack of rain fall this winter could cause a critical condition during hazardous  
humidity conditions this summer.  
The present water system was pumped dry within a 1.5 hr. period this past February.

- ① approx. Two million gallons would be needed to suppress a major yard fire.
- ② up to 200,000 gallons could be utilized daily for log deck sprinkling, equipment washing, and misc. industrial use.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 3.3 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from South Fork of the Coos River

The use to which this water is to be applied is industrial use in sorting yard including fire protection and log deck sprinkling.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is April 12, 1977

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 28, 1978 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1979

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1980
