1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Applegate River,  
a tributary of Rogue River.

2. The point of diversion is to be located 1050 ft. S. and 500 ft. W.  
(N. or S.) (E. or W.)  
 from the N<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> corner of Sec. 25  
(Public Land Survey Corner)

being within the NE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of  
Sec. 25 Tp. 38 S. R. 4 W., W. M., in the county of Jackson  
(N. or S.) (E. or W.)

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

New Berryman Ditch and diversion structure:

Pumping system from New Berryman Ditch will consist of a 3" x 2" centrifugal pump powered by a 15 H.P. gasoline engine to raise the water into a small gravity ditch for flood irrigation.

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Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.24 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Applegate River

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/40th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is April 13, 1977

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 28, 1978 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1979

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1980
